Minutes of Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 13th February 2017 at 7.30 pm in the Recreation Ground Pavilion

PUBLIC OPEN FORUM

PRESENT 11 Parish Councillors, Mr T Hatrick (PTLO), Mrs P O'Brien (CC), Mrs S B Harvey (DC), 7 Parishioners.

1. **Police Report**

Information about the Police Connect messaging service was noted and circulated (c170123), from which was recorded 2 incidents of hare coursing and a vehicle tampering during December.

2. **Parishioners Questions**

In response to parishioners present it was confirmed that the Council, together with surrounding parishes, had lodged strongly worded objections and rebuttals to the Innocence Lane Scoping presentation and are partaking in a joint subcommittee from surrounding parishes to seek a meeting with the Head of Planning at SCDC to discuss the issue.

3. **County Councillor's Report**

Mrs O'Brien (CC) recorded (c170164) that the County had agreed its budget increase of 3%, which will go towards Adult social care; efforts to achieve efficiencies continue. Her main focus had been the Police and Crime Panel, which she chairs, and the rationale behind its precept increase. Continued investment in combating Cybercrime was a major issue.

4. **District Councillor's Report**

Mrs Harvey (DC) reported (c170131/150/145) on the historic decision to merge SCDC and Waveney DC and commented on the possible effects on councillor numbers. A review of the Core Strategy started on 9th February. She encouraged councils to consider Neighbourhood Plans. She would be visiting the docks during the next week and agreed to raise the problem of queuing lorries raised by one parishioner.

Both Councillors noted the huge response to the Innocence Farm Scoping, but were urged to consider pollution the most important aspect.

5. **PTLO Report**

Mr Hatrick had nothing to report on bus services (c170116), although he had raised with the bus company anomalies in the routes buses take through the village, which appear resolved.

The chairman closed POF and opened Parish Council meeting at 8.15pm

The Falkenham Rd footway was viable but there was no finance available. Verge cutting was not relevant at this time of year. **SCC**

Agreed that some form of posts should be placed along the verge to control parking (c170038). Councillor Jacobs would request from S Harvey (DC) a contribution from her Community Budget. **DJ/SH**

Following a suggestion from the Clerk that POF be moved to the body of the agenda, agreed no change should be made.

S Harvey (DC) had a contact telephone number which she would pursue. **SH**

Agreed Clerk should write to SCC requesting additional double yellow lines **CLERK** should be inserted between the school and Back Lane to provide refuge for overtaking.

RECREATION GROUND

Pavilion : No new problems. The tiles damaged due to the flooding in the ladies toilet and one of the shower rooms are due to be replaced W/C March 6th. Awaiting a quote to renew ALL the pipework in the pavilion.

Play-Area : Meeting with VERTAS, our supplier of the new equipment, is due on March 6th. They want to attempt to complete the project by the end of March.

Fitness Equipment / Zip wire : Paintwork touching up on the fitness equipment will now have to wait until the summer.

Ground : In conjunction with Derek Jacobs, we need to write to TW to let them know our final requirements at the entrance/exit to the ground from the new site – this involves the possibility of some sort of gate/barrier in the path at that point. We are still looking at replacing our ageing floodlights in the summer. Much depends on funding !! We have agreed that TW can park some cars on our car park during the week as they are desperately short of space on their site. It will be strictly controlled by the TW site manager. A rental fee has been agreed with them.

Mobile Phone Mast: This project, which seemed too good to be true in any case, has now

become a bit of a farce. Three companies are now seeking permission in Kirton for a mast in different locations. The latest is at B&M, and this seems the furthest advanced as they are putting in for planning permission around W/C March 6th. It seems a great shame that all the funding will go to a 'private' business, and not at all to the village. J Beer March 2017.
