Minutes of Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 9th September 2013 at 7.30 pm in the Recreation Ground Pavilion

PUBLIC OPEN FORUM

PRESENT 7 Parish Councillors, Mrs S B Harvey (DC), Mr G A Harding (DC), 3 Parishioners.

1. **Police Report**

The police could not attend but submitted a report recording 2 burglaries within the Parish during July and August. Staffing changes (c130554) noted.

2. **Parishioners Questions**

A parishioner raised concerns about pedestrian safety on Back Road following the creation of the new entrance for B & M. The Clerk confirmed that the final approval to the entrance, permitted vehicle movements between 8am and 6pm. The Council had been disappointed with this decision itself, and although it had expressed this at the time, no response had been forthcoming. Agreed a response to these concerns should be sought from SCDC. Mr Harding (DC) undertook to also make enquiries about the Back Road problems.

A parishioner present, introduced himself as an Emergency Planning Officer, in private life, offered his assistance in this area. Chairman will meet and discuss.

3. <u>County Councillor's Report</u>

Mrs O'Brien (CC) sent in written reports which drew attention to night closures of A14 between Seven Hills and Copdock during October (c130648), most particularly emphasising that agreement had been reached that these would be sectional and not start until 10pm, and the ongoing efforts to drive up educational standards. Trading Standards had successfully brought a prosecution of persons involved in a scam involving money laundering and fraud.

4. <u>District Councillors' Reports</u>

Mrs Harvey (DC) spoke about the review by the Boundary Commission of District Wards which would reduce the number of District Councillors from 53 to 42. She emphasised that views should be made to the Boundary Commission and Mr Kerry (DC). She publicised a plan to open, in the Church Hall from October, as an experiment, a base to make services available to parishioners from CAB, Flagship Housing, Nassau Trust and Food Bank info. She had discussed with SCC the problems at the Back Road junction (c130574/99). Mr Harding (DC) reported on the resurfacing of A14 past Trimley, which had been delayed, but is now underway. Mr Kerry (DC) had sent a written report which outlined SCDC's thinking on the Boundary Review that suggested this Parish should be realigned with the rural parishes, rather than with the Trimleys as at present. He noted further that SCDC continues to work on a policy for future Sports and Leisure; he refuted a rumour that Brackenbury was to be closed.

5. **PTLO REPORT**

In a written report Mr Negus said that progress had been made in getting buses to follow the village loop. However, a parishioner present said this was not happening, which will be taken up with Mr Negus.

Councillor Paul asked that SCC be advised that a 30mph sign in Park Lane required attention. The pothole at the entrance to Parks Lane had been repaired; again. The Chairman would discuss with SCC the provision of SID signs on Trimley/Kirton Roads.
